

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

PRICES:

Double occupancy fares are per guest, and do not include port fees of \$159. Government taxes of \$100.45 are additional for all guests and due with final payment. Government taxes and port fees are not guaranteed and subject to change at any time. Celebrity Cruises reserves the right to re-instate a fuel supplement for all guests if the NYMEX oil price exceeds \$70 a barrel. 3rd/4th person share fares are per guest and applicable when first two persons in stateroom pay full, per guest, double occupancy fares. All prices are subject to change, availability and advance purchase requirements. Celebrity's group fares are not combinable with other Celebrity promotions and discounts unless expressly authorized by Celebrity Cruise. Other conditions may apply.

BAMBUSA BONUS:

The Bonus inclusions are based on a minimum of 25 double occupancy staterooms sold when booked into The Travel Concierge/ Bambusa group and include 1) \$75 onboard credit per double occupancy stateroom; 2) one group Cocktail party, 'shared' with other groups on board this sailing. RESERVATION & PAYMENT:

DEPOSIT: 1st deposit = \$100 per person for category guarantee or \$250 per person for cabin assignment by February 26, 2010**. 2nd deposit = \$450 per person by May 21, 2010

**Double deposit required on Aqua and Concierge Class.

FINAL PAYMENT: Due to The Travel Concierge no later than **July 7, 2010**.

NOTE: All reservations are for assigned cabin categories.

NOTE: Reservations must be made in exactly the names as they appear on the passport. Date of Birth is required at time of reservation.

The Travel Concierge accepts most major credit and debit cards. Phone bookings require a faxed credit card authorization and travel insurance waiver if travel insurance is not purchased to The Travel Concierge at 239.331.5609.

CANCELLATION & OTHER PENALTIES (ACCESSED BY CELEBRITY CRUISES):

Celebrity Cruises charges penalties as follows (name changes are considered cancellations and re-bookings):

Cancel prior to July 13, 2010:	no cancellation penalty.
Cancel from July 14, 2010 – August 20, 2010:	\$250 per guest cancellation fee
Cancel from August 21, 2010 – September 10, 2010:	50% per guest cancellation fee
Cancel on or after September 11, 2010 (or, no-show at pier):	100% per guest cancellation fee

Penalties for voluntary changes to your reservation apply and are determined by the type of change and when the change is requested. Other conditions and policies apply.

Cancellations must be made in writing to The Travel Concierge.

TRAVEL INSURANCE – HIGHLY RECOMMENDED

The Travel Concierge highly recommends that you purchase travel insurance within 7 days of booking. **Should you choose not to purchase travel insurance, The Travel Concierge requires a signed TRAVEL INSURANCE WAIVER submitted at time of reservation.**

The Travel Concierge offers Travel Guard travel insurance for full protection. Please inquire.

PROOF OF CITIZENSHIP & OTHER DOCUMENTATION:

Passengers must have valid passport and will be denied boarding at the pier without proper documentation.

Please refer to the U.S. Government State Department web site for updates on details on how to obtain a U.S. passport at www.state.gov

The names (first and last) on your proof of citizenship must exactly match the names on your travel reservation.

Non- U.S. Citizens should consult with The Travel Concierge at time of reservation for proof of citizenship requirements. While The Travel Concierge is happy to offer guidance, it is the passengers' sole responsibility to secure and carry proper and required proof of citizenship papers, insurance & documents.

Minor Children (21 years and under) who are not traveling with a parent or guardian, must have The Travel Concierge "Parent/Guardian Permission Form" completed and returned to The Travel Concierge at time of final payment. If parent/guardian is traveling but not sharing cabin with the minor, additional Celebrity policies may apply. Please confirm all Celebrity policies within Celebrity's brochure at time of reservation.

MINIMUM AGE REQUIREMENTS:

Celebrity has minimum age requirements. If any guests are under the age of 21 years, they must be accompanied by a parent, grandparent or legal guardian 25 years or older in the same stateroom.

NOT INCLUDED (UNLESS OTHERWISE PRE-PAID):
